



Roles

A Character

Character is determined by personal beliefs.

My beliefs that form my perspective of reality also determine the character of the role that I play in that reality.

As my environment changes and my role in that environment changes, my character changes accordingly.

I may have the same personality & character at home as at work, or they may differ.

I may have the same beliefs about the reality of my home life as I do about my work life, or they may be different.

My character will change according to my beliefs about my environment.

A very distinct change in my belief system, caused by a dramatic or traumatic fearful experience, can cause a very distinct change in my character.

A similarly positive dramatic experience, such as a lottery win, can have the opposite effect on both my personality & my character.

Character is a choice, although that choice may be made at a sub-conscious level of the mind.

A Personality

Personality is driven by emotional needs.

We all have our own set of emotional needs that may be similar or different to other people but are always unique to our Self.

Emotional needs determine personality because emotional needs are personal to the reality of each Individual.

An extrovert personality needs other people to meet their emotional needs.

An introvert personality meets its own emotional needs.

An overt personality has no emotional needs.

An overt personality is open to and accepting of all situations & occurrences.

Personality & mood is driven by the need for emotional energy and the sub-conscious strategies for competing with other people to gain emotional energy.

People with similar or opposing needs attract people with similar or opposing needs.

The need to care for others attracts the need to be cared for.

The need to approve of others attracts others who need approval.

Emotional needs are energetic & directly subject to the Law of Attraction.

Personality & Character

My **Personality** is determined by my emotional energy needs.

My unique set of emotional needs determines my individual personality.

We all have a unique personality that is determined by our own personal set of emotional needs.

Each Individual has up to 10 different emotional needs arranged in a priority order that is determined by their current circumstances.

As my circumstances change, my emotional need for energy changes, how I sub-consciously meet that need changes and with it, my personality changes.

Personality often changes between home-life and work-life because the need for emotional energy changes and how the need is met changes.

My **Character** is determined by my belief system.

My belief system determines the character of the role that I am playing in life.

Different beliefs create different characters in different cultures, races, creeds and societies.

My beliefs about what I am doing determines the role that I am actioning and the character that I am adopting.

The belief that I am either a girl or a boy, or a man or a woman, creates my male or female characteristics.

As I change my need for emotional power, my personality changes.

As I become aware of and change my sub-conscious beliefs, my actions change and my character changes.

Neither my personality nor my character are my True Identity.

Man

'Man' is the physical manifestation of Soul.

Woman & man is a duality of divided gender that is separated from their Soul. The Soul is not divided by gender, nor is 'Man'. For a man or woman to become 'Man' as a physical incarnation, they are required to re-unite their opposing genders. When man & woman experience a 'coming' together energetically they both, for a brief moment in time, experience the Oneness of Man & Soul.

The 'Son of Man' has the 'Ability of Man' to be united in their male and female gender, as is their Soul.

By the Law of Attraction, male and female energy will always seek to become re- united. When male energy seeks female energy, it is called lust or wanting sex. When female energy seeks male energy, it is called love or needing romance.

A True Soul connection is when 'Man' has the ability to share their Love & their Light with their fellow 'Man'.

Empaths & Sensitives

Empaths intuitively sense people's male directive energy by the polarity of their thinking. Being empathic is sensing directive thoughts. I empathically know what you are thinking.

Sensitives intuitively sense people's female supportive energy by the gender of their emotions. Being sensitive is sensing supporting emotional feelings. I sense the emotion you are feeling.

Empaths & Sensitives are a duality of male & female psychic energy. A true Psychic, intuitively connects with Soul or Source Vibrational Energy (the Psyche). Intuition is a Triality of psychic thoughts, feelings & experiences.

- Gnostics intuitively know with psychic thoughts
- Sensitives intuitively feel with psychic feelings
- Seers intuitively see with psychic experiences

Confusion arises when trying to guide & support other people.

When relating to other people, a state of being sensitively detached is essential for empaths & sensitives. Empaths are required to be sensitive and sensitives are required to be detached. The essence of a beneficial relationship is sensitivity for emotional support, whilst remaining detached from the trauma of other people's personal dramas.

Following my own path, with guidance and support from my own Soul, requires my being both sensitive & empathic. When I intuitively know & feel what is right & good for my Self, I see my own present direction clearly. My exclusive connection with my Soul allows my exclusive connection to the direction of my path and the support that I require to follow it.

My exclusive connection with my Soul allows my sensitive detachment with other people.

My ego is my disconnected sense of Self and my Soul is my connected sense of Selves. All is connected at the Soul Level of conscious-awareness but all is disconnected, yet attached, at the level of the conscious ego physical sense of self.

Any sensitive attachment to other people directs my empathy in the opposite polarity of sympathy. Any insensitive disconnection polarises me towards apathy. Without emotional intelligence, being sensitive will feel too sensitive, over sensitive or overwhelmingly hyper sensitive and being empathic will become either apathetic or sympathetic.

Being in sympathy with another is an emotional attachment. I need to be sympathetic with whomever I need emotionally. Sympathy is a negative vibrational resonance with someone that I am attached to because I need them emotionally.

Being apathetic with another is a mental disconnection. I do not like them because my thinking does not resonate with their beliefs or behaviour, so I disconnect from them.

Being empathic with another is compassionately sharing a similar path with them. Without the sensitivity to support them on their path, we will inadvertently guide them along our path.

The Law of Attraction brings people together who empathically share the same path. It also attracts sensitive people with contrasting or complimentary genders of emotional feelings.

Without the emotional intelligence of sensitive detachment, it is difficult to discern who has empathy with our own path and who does not.

Without an exclusive Soul connection, there is no intuitive sensitivity or empathy, just an inclusive disconnection from any guidance & support from Source Energy. My inclusive attachment to others offers me no genuine support and my insensitive disconnection offers no authentic guidance.

Being empathically sensitive unites my male mental thoughts with my female emotional feelings and empowers my intuitive inspiration.

It is my exclusive connection to Soul, with my sensitive detachment with others, that allows the guidance & support for my Self to guide & support other sensitive empaths.

Sensitives attract empaths and empaths attract sensitives. It is the Law.

The Critic

The 'critic' needs to be right and to justify their own perspective of reality as being the real truth.

The critic believes that there is only one perfect reality that we all seek and the critic becomes the guardian of that singular reality.

One singular reality cannot exist in a dual reality world created for the purpose of experiencing extreme polarities of opposing reality, and everything in between.

Duality, or relative existence with dual polarity, cannot by definition have one fixed reality. This three dimensional realm, of Space-Time-Reality, has infinite spaces, eternal times, and multiple continuous realities. 'Multiple continuous realities' means that we each have created and exist within our own reality, as we exist within our own space and our own time.

Our reality is very valuable and is defined by our True Values and is as unique and valuable to us as is our valuable 'time' and our valuable 'space'. We appreciate how valuable our time is when we run out of time, and we appreciate how valuable our space is when we are deprived of it. We appreciate our reality, and our reality appreciates, once we appreciate that we create our own reality.

The critic, however, compares their reality to the reality of another in order to make a valued judgment of which reality is real, by virtue of its superior existence. The criticism of a judgmental critic may be valued but is never appreciated.

Superior and inferior are just a subjective judgment of what is good, better or best as opposed to what is bad, worse or worst. They measure a scale of relative perfection in a world that is designed to be relative and imperfect.

In a truly 'perfect world', criticism is not possible as everything is perfect and cannot therefore, by definition, be criticised.

It is the imperfection of this world that allows the critic to exist and to make judgments of relative imperfection that exist as criticism. If perfection is being right then the critic can never be 'right', except of course from the perspective of their own reality.

A Bigot

Bigotry is the intolerance of someone else's beliefs. A bigot is so convicted by their own version of the truth that they find any beliefs to the contrary to be unacceptable.

A bigot is unable to accept or even tolerate someone whose beliefs are in opposition to their own. The more zealous that someone is in their system of belief, the more bigoted they become.

Religious intolerance is a common form of bigotry. Both religious dogmatists and non-religious atheists are often convicted by their own bigotry.

The inability to accept another person's perspective of the truth is based on an unshakeable belief that there is only one true reality and the desperate need for that one true reality to be in alignment with one's own system of belief.

Bigots need to be right and go to great lengths to prove other people wrong, in order to prove the validity of their own beliefs.

Bigotry is caused by the mental reasoning of a flawed intellect.

When reality is relative to the perspective of the Individual, right & wrong is just a judgment that is relative to that individual's set of beliefs. Nothing is inherently right or wrong, it is just a personal perspective of what is deemed to be beneficial or detrimental to oneself.

When I am intolerant of someone else's beliefs, I will also be intolerant of someone else's behaviour because behaviour always follows beliefs. My personal standards of behaviour always align with my personal belief system.

When someone behaves in an unexpected or unacceptable way, it is because their belief about the reality of that moment in time is different to mine. To overcome bigotry, I am required to be

accepting of the fact that other people behave in alignment with their beliefs, which form the basis of their perspective of how they experience their reality; and so do I.

When I attract a bigot into my reality, it is to show my Self the intolerance that I am experiencing to someone else's beliefs, opinions & convictions, which they deem to be true.

When I allow all others to create & perceive their own perspective of reality, based on their own version of what is true, they allow me to do the same. This is the Law and the Golden Rule.

Attempting to manipulate other people or coerce them into believing that only what I believe is true, makes me a bigot.

The absolute truth of reality is by god not bi got. By God, I will learn the absolute truth about reality. By Man, I will experience a relative truth held uniquely by each individual person.

Bigotry is the path of enforcing my truth onto other people. In truth, we are all convicted by our own truths & untruths.

A bigot may implicitly trust their own beliefs yet have absolutely no faith in their own life path.

An Idiot

An Idiot is a person whose rational intellect is compromised or overridden by their emotional needs.

I.D.I.O.T. is an acronym for ID Is Out There or ID Is On Top.

The ID is our sub-conscious sense of ego self. Responsible for instinctively getting our emotional needs met. I am driven sub-consciously to get my emotional needs met until I become consciously aware of what I need emotionally.

Being unaware of my emotional needs is normal but not idiotic. It is when I am driven to meet my emotional needs in an irrational way that I am being an idiot and behaving like an idiot.

Every addiction is a substitute for emotional power. When I am obsessively driven to meet my need for emotional energy, with an addictive substance or in an addictive way, I am an idiot.

Idiotic behaviour overrides my sane, logical, rational, intellect when:

- I know that drinking alcohol is damaging my liver
- I know that binge eating fat & sugar makes me fat & lethargic
- I know that prescription drugs are not curing my illness
- I know that smoking tobacco is a health risk
- I know that working 14 hours a day is slowly killing me
- I know that illegal drugs are banned for a reason

These are just a few examples of our sub-conscious need for emotional power taking precedence over our intellectual reasoning. In a battle between instinct & intellect, instinct instinctively wins.

Intellectual Idiots prove that acting like an idiot is not due to a lack of rational intelligence. Idiotic behaviour is not relative to the lack

of rational intelligence but it is relative to the awareness of our emotional intelligence.

An emotionally intelligent idiot is an oxymoron. An emotionally intelligent person is aware of their own emotional needs and consciously meets them efficiently, effectively & effortlessly without the need for any addictive substance.

We live in an idiotic world of emotionally disconnected & insensitive people until we become aware of the joy of our own content fulfilment, expressed with a wealth of personal healthy wisdom.

An Intelligent Idiot

An Intelligent Idiot is an oxymoron.

An idiot lacks either rational or emotional intelligence, or both.

A knowledgeable idiot is possible because knowledge does not make me intelligent.

IQ & EQ are not a measure of knowledge but a measure of rational & emotional intelligence.

A lack of knowledge does not make me an idiot.

I can be highly intelligent yet lack knowledge of many things in many areas of existence.

I can have recall to lots of knowledge yet have no intelligent idea of how to use it.

Using my knowledge to compete in a general knowledge quiz is not particularly intelligent, although it may be fun.

An idiot is limited by their sub-conscious mental programming.

Intelligence is always expansive, never limiting.

My sub-conscious id is not intelligent, yet it holds all my knowledge.

It has the intelligence of a tape recorder.

Garbage in creates garbage out and the actions of an idiot.

Knowledge in equals knowledge out like a reference manual.

Only an idiot chooses knowledge over intelligence.

Plebeians & Patricians

In Roman Society, Patricians were the elite ruling class and Plebeians were the common masses.

Patricians are the ruling class who lead the way.

Plebeians are the subjects of the ruling class and follow their lead.

Patricians make the rules.

Plebs follow other people's rules.

Neither role is sovereign.

A sovereign entity follows their own path.

They have no need of others' rules, laws, ethics, principles, morals or standards and make none for others to follow.

They require no followers and lead their own life along their own exclusive, individual & unique chosen path.

Plebeians follow the path of their rulers.

Patricians follow the principles, ethics, morals and standards of their ego's will, which they turn into rules & laws for others to follow.

Sovereignty follows the vision of its destiny.

It is neither my vision nor my destiny to rule others or to be ruled by others.

A Pleasant Peasant

A Peasant is an appeasing & humble person.
They historically appease the arrogance of their ruling nobility.
They please the greed of their lords & masters.
A peasant is inferior to the superiority of the court of a monarch.

A Pleasant person pleases others.
An unpleasant person displeases others.
Pleasant people are humble & pleasing.
Arrogant, greedy, superior people do not need to be pleasant.
Nor do they consider themselves unpleasant.
Nor do they consider themselves peasants.

It is the peasant who considers the ruling classes to be greedy,
arrogant, superior & unpleasant.
Yet still the peasant pleases & appeases like a good humble
servant.

A Genuine Rogue

A Rogue is someone who does not conform to the status quo. Someone is seen to be a rogue when they operate outside of accepted authority.

Following one's own path often encounters a rogue in action.

Being Genuine is being accepted as real.

When I conform to accepted reality, I am seen to be genuine.

Genuine people act and behave as others expect them to.

A loveable rogue is a non-conformist that acts in an acceptable way.

A Genuine Rogue conforms to their own authority and creates their own reality.

They are Truly Selfish and their authority is genuine.

They know that their path is unique and different to all others and that the reality they create is genuine although different to the accepted norm of society.

The Pragmatist & The Romantic

A Pragmatist creates a practical reality that is based on experienced fact. A Romantic creates an imaginary reality that is based on fiction.

Pragmatists & Romantics are both trapped within a dual reality world of fact or fiction, truth or untruth, embroiled in a battle between the rational mind and the emotional heart.

A Pragmatist believes that ideals are unattainable in their experience and to be Idealistic means having high ideals, which is being romantic.

A Romantic believes that an ideal world only exists within their own imagination and to be Idealistic means facing reality, which is being pragmatic.

A Realist believes in the literal truth, whereas a Romanticist prefers literal fantasy and fiction.

A Pragmatist believes in the practical truth and makes that fact a reality, whereas a Fantasist believes their reality to be a fact.

The Truth is that neither being Pragmatic nor being Romantic is a Realism that allows my Self to Realise my own Ideal Reality in a Realistic way.

Patients & Waiters

Patients & Waiters belong to two different service industries. Nurses service patients in the Health Sector and Waiters serve customers in the Catering Trade.

Patience & Waiting, we are taught, go together. We learn that it is good manners to wait patiently because that is how we tolerate the inconvenience of having to wait. Waiting impatiently is a toleration that is becoming intolerable and is showing a lack of good etiquette.

Patients in hospital have no choice but to wait patiently for a nurse to take care of whatever they need. Customers in restaurants choose not to wait too long for a waiter to serve them. When a waiter causes a customer to wait longer than expected the customer complains, gets angry and displays the wrath of their displeasure. When a customer complains at having to wait too long to be served, the waiter is expected to be humble, meek & apologetic for the apparent poor service. When a nurse causes a patient to wait too long, the patient has no option but to be patient. The nurse diligently takes care to carry out her service with pride and decides when giving care to the patient is appropriate & convenient. The patient is required to be humble, as long as the nurse is seen to have humility; which is often confused with the nurse's arrogance or indignation and the patient's pride, which is called dignity.

As a society, we believe that everyone should be allowed to die with dignity even though a waiting patient's indignity will test the patience of any nurse. Waiters are confronted with the indignity of complaining customers. Indignant customers are displeased when they run out of patience waiting for a waiter to give a standard of expected service that is believed to be deserved.

In the control dramas of personal interaction, it is acceptable for a waiter to be aloof, when being interrogated by a customer, but it is not acceptable for a nurse to be an intimidator, when nursing a poor me patient.

There is nothing more intimidating, humiliating & embarrassing as having to be cared for by a nurse. There is nothing more intimidating than a poor waiter having to confront an angry customer who has run out of patience.

In my ideal world, everything is served up providentially in divine time and nobody ever has to wait patiently for anything. With faith in providence providing everything in divine time, there is no expectation of anything being either early or late. Without expectation there is no judgment, there is no controlling drama, there are no aloof waiters, there are no indignant customers, there are no proud nurses and there are no poor me patients.

Nobody is patiently waiting for God because everyone is enjoying everything that is being served up as a divine experience of an ideal life.

The Alchemist

The Alchemist has found the secret of turning base metal into gold. With this secret the Alchemist knows that he has no need of gold. Gold is a measure of a Man's riches and also a metaphor for a Man's Wealth.

It is possible to be materially rich but not wealthy.

It is impossible to be wealthy and to be poor.

The Alchemist knows that he need never be poor.

He also knows that he need never be rich.

He knows that he needs enough gold only for what he needs.

As the Alchemist is wealthy, he has everything he needs, and therefore has no need of the gold.

He knows that gold is no substitute for wealth and that a wealthy man has all the gold that he needs.

It is his knowing that allows his being wealthy, not the gold.

Knowing how to turn base metal into gold is worth more than the gold itself.

Knowing how to turn his fate into his destiny is beyond price, and beyond the prize of gold.

Being A Wizard

Being a Wizard is overcoming the restraints of dual reality relative physical existence.

When I overcome the duality of a hard or easy life, it becomes effortless, life is a whizz and I am being a wizard.

A Wizard has no duality of gender, being neither a witch nor a warlock.

A Wizard has no opposing polarity being neither good nor evil.

It is a witch or a warlock that is eternally locked in a battle between good & evil, never a Wizard.

A warlock chooses to fight for good or evil whilst a witch decides to cast a spell of light or a spell of darkness.

A Wizard doesn't cast spells but does experience miracles.

A Wizard knows the miracle of an effortless life.

When life is a whizz, I am a Wizard and life is divine.

The Entitler

The Entitler is entitled to their entitlement.

My entitlement is my provision & my allowance.

I am entitled to my choice.

To choose my ideal choice, I am required to name it or give it a title.

I cannot choose that which I cannot define.

With definition it can become definite in my reality.

I am not entitled to that which I cannot define as my reality.

The Entitler defines their own meaning, reason, & purpose for their life.

I am entitled to the vision of a mission in life that has true value for me.

I am entitled to that which I entitle & define as my manifest.

An indefinite manifestation is not a reality.

I am entitled to define & manifest my own reality.

This is the entitlement of the Entitler.

The Neutral Observer

The Neutral Observer is sensitively detached from the dramas of a relative dual reality world.

The Neutral Observer is neither:

- The Pacifist nor the Warmonger
- The Terrorist nor the Freedom Fighter
- The Victim nor the Villain
- The Master nor the Slave
- The Intimidator nor the Poor Me
- The Interrogator nor the Aloof
- The Beauty nor the Beast
- A Good Samaritan nor a Bad Samaritan
- St. George nor the Dragon

The Neutral Observer always:

- Responds in a balanced & harmonious way
- Allows all others to follow their own path
- Knows that all others have their own unique path to follow
- Follows their own path without resistance to others
- Knows their own path is beneficial & flows effortlessly through them
- Creates their own reality that is never detrimental to another
- Accepts whatever turns up as an opportunity for personal growth
- Is in this world but not of this world
- Treats the playground as a place where all games are acceptable

The Neutral Observer is neither a Competitor nor a Spectator.

The Poor Me

The Poor Me is the victim of someone else's fears and beliefs. By making themselves a victim of someone else's actions, they seek the emotional energy of sympathy from others.

The more the poor me can become the hero of their own victimhood, the more emotional energy they can gain from their drama.

The poor me has a great deal of emotional energy invested in being the victim of their own life.

They believe that they are the victim of whatever is occurring in their life.

Poor me's need to become very strong emotionally in order to survive the extent of their own victimhood.

The more their emotional energy becomes depleted the more they will seek to become a bigger and bigger victim of life to justify their lack of energy.

The more depleted my emotional energy becomes, the more I become a victim of my life, poor me.

Prime examples of a poor me are a Hypochondriac and someone who is Clinically Obese.

Both of these examples tend to attract bullies because a poor me always attracts an intimidator, who always attracts a poor victim to intimidate.

The Intimidator

The Intimidator is a victim of their own fear.

Their fear is created by their false and limiting beliefs about their life.

Their false, negative fears create a state of low emotional energy.

The Intimidator seeks to victimise the cause of their low emotional energy.

As they do not see their own beliefs as the cause of their energy drain, they seek to find the villain that they believe is victimising them.

The motto of the intimidator is "the best form of defence is attack".

They will attack anyone who they believe is draining their energy or they believe can and will drain their energy.

Never intimidate an intimidator because they recognise their own drama and will react accordingly.

Prime examples of an intimidator are the „School Bully“ and the „Autocratic Dictator“. All intimidators are emotional Poor Me"s.

With enough emotional energy, I have no need or inclination to attack anyone and no need to defend myself from the intimidation of others.

The Aloof

The Aloof has very weak boundaries and consistently drains emotional energy to other people.

They believe that the only way to avoid the drain on their energy is to withdraw into the solitude of their own „cave“.

The over sensitive aloof blames others for their low state of emotional energy and sees the only solution as a tactical withdrawal.

It is in the solitude of their cave that the aloof is able to find the solution to their problem and get their emotional needs met.

They will only emerge from their solitude once they have solved their problems and regained their energy.

With no apparent problems the aloof has no reason to be aloof.

They know that other people's solutions will never solve their problems even though they believe that other people's solutions may well have created them.

When the aloof realises that they are not the victim of other people's problems, they will no longer drain energy to trying to find solutions to other people's problems and no longer need to be aloof.

The prime examples of an Aloof are a Hen-pecked Husband and a Mummy's Boy. Aloofs attract Interrogators who in turn attract Aloofs.

The Interrogator

The Interrogator seeks to find the cause of their own problems. The cause of their problems is always their own emotional energy deficit.

A low level of emotional energy manifests the problems that appear to be occurring in life.

An Interrogator does not see their self as the cause of their own problems.

They do not own their own problems and look to blame others for what is occurring in their life.

They seek to blame the cause of their problems onto whoever they believe is to blame for causing them.

A good interrogator has developed strong analytical skills that are honed to accurately judge the exact cause of whatever they are having to tolerate and endure.

Their negative search for who is depleting their own emotional energy, requires their victims energy to fuel it.

They seek to control the emotional energy of another with their criticism, their cynicism, their sarcasm, their complaining and their condemnation.

The deterrent to a persistent interrogator is to become aloof and exclude oneself from their persistent search for what they believe is their truth.

Prime examples of the Interrogator are the Nagging Wife and the Over-protective Mother.

The Freedom Fighting Terrorist

By the Law of Attraction, I create the focus of my attention.

I draw the focus of my thoughts into my reality.

The focus of a Freedom Fighter is the terror of losing their freedom.

A person who is truly free has no need to fight for their freedom.

A person who is fearful of losing their freedom, focuses on the terrorist who they believe will take away their perceived freedom.

Focusing on losing my freedom creates a reality of not having my freedom.

Anti-terrorism creates a compromised freedom.

Anti-terrorists are freedom fighters who create terror in the minds of the terrorists.

Their aim is to take away the freedom of the terrorist.

They are a Government Army of freedom fighters who deal out terror in the cause of freedom.

Freedom will never be caused by the effect of the terror of fighting for it.

Terrorists become a non-governmental army who are fighting for the freedom that they have lost to a government army of freedom fighting anti-terrorists.

I do not have to fight anyone for a freedom that is inherently mine to choose and to experience for my Self.

The Devil

The Devil is a figment of the imagination.

Imagination is powerful enough to be creative.

A powerful imagination can create a perspective of real evil & curses or a perception of real goodness & blessings.

The devil is the imaginary authority that makes things go really wrong.

It is the idol that we blame when we are not ascending to the highest authority of our Self.

In my own authority of choice, I would never choose to live in a negative world that is ruled by an evil devil; whether created by my own beliefs or those of someone else.

It is only in the denial of my highest authority & creative choice that I invent something to blame for my ills, my woes & my victimhood.

The devil is always in the detail of my mental programming.

Overcoming fears, limiting beliefs & perspectives of duality disallows the existence of evil.

Of evil is the d'evil.

Pure authorised thought knows that the devil does not exist in an ideal life, in an ideal world.

The Richest Man In Babylon

The Richest Man in Babylon invested 10% of all his income throughout his working life.

From his first wage packet, he put 1/10th of his gross income into the bank and never withdrew any capital.

He also put 10% of any other income he received into his savings account and never withdrew anything.

During times of scarcity he lived off 90% of the interest gained on his capital.

The other 10% of interest earned he re-invested as savings that he never touched.

He became very rich because of the interest gained on the interest gained on the money that was always appreciating and he never withdrew.

The way to become very rich is to never spend more than 90% of whatever you receive including the interest earned on the money that you save.

Money then becomes an appreciating asset that is saved rather than a depreciating asset that is spent.

Whenever I spend money that I have saved it will depreciate my riches and depreciate the ability of my money to appreciate.

Becoming the Richest Man in Babylon will never make me the Wealthiest Man in Paradise.

The Wealthiest Man In Paradise

The Wealthiest Man in Paradise does not need money.

I do not need money when I have enough.

The wealthiest Man in paradise always has enough money.

Knowing that I always have enough money is my present to my Self.

I know that I can only ever have enough money for right now.

My present for my Self is only presented and only acceptable in every present moment of time.

With hindsight, I know that I always had enough in the past.

With foresight, I know that I will always have enough in the future.

With insight, I know that enough right now is abundance.

The Wealthiest Man in Paradise experiences an abundance of everything that is required in every moment of time.

My wealth is relative to my ability to see just that.

The Inquistive & The Inquisitor

- The Inquistive is curious, keen, searching & inquiring.
- The Inquisitor is prying, enquiring, snooping & meddlesome.
- The Inquistive is seeking their own path in life.
- The Inquisitor is ensuring that others are following the path of their dogma & doctrine.
- The Inquisitor follows the morals, ethics & principles of their religion or creed.
- The Inquistive follows their true values & their faith in their own core beliefs.
- The Inquistive is inquiring into a vision of their own truth.
- The Inquisitor is the judge of a commonly accepted belief.
- The Inquisitor is an Interrogator & an Intimidator.
- The Inquistive is a Sensitive & a Seer.
- The Inquisitor ensures that the right knowledge is taught & learned.
- The Inquistive knows the feeling of their own intuitive insight.
- The Inquisitor experiences the intensity of their own life dramas.
- The Inquistive experiences the fulfilment of their own life potential.

The Opportunist & The Profiteer

- The Opportunist sees and accepts whatever is occurring in life as an opportunity.
- The Profiteer seeks to profit from life and turn what is occurring to their advantage.

The Player

The Spectator is a passive non-participant who watches the little pictures in life.

The Participator takes a part in the action and acts out the dramas.

The Competitor is a participant who takes part in order to be better than their opponents.

Competitors play to win.

Participants play to take part and share the action.

Spectators watch the action.

Observers choose to stay out of the drama so that they can better see whatever is occurring.

Players actively enjoy playing the Game of Life.

Students & Pupils

I am a Student of a Course.

I am a Pupil of a Teacher.

Pupil & Teacher is a role duality.

It is where one believes that they have the knowledge and the other believes that they need the knowledge.

It is the duality of superiority and inferiority.

The pupil will always defer to the superior knowledge of the teacher.

It is only in my disconnection from the Truth that I seek to become the pupil of a teacher.

Jesus is the example of a Teacher without pupils. A Disciple is the student of a course, not a pupil.

My Inner Teacher and Coach does not seek to teach me about life.

My Inner Coach has given to my Self the gift of Life for the purpose of learning and growth.

My Soul chooses for my Self to be a Student of Life and to allow life to follow its natural course for my Self.

I am a student of the Nature of Life – of course.

Teachers teach, pupils are taught, students learn and disciples follow their own path.

A Spiritual Coach

A Spiritual Coach coaches spiritual people.

A spiritual person has awakened to the reality of their spiritual path in life.

They require a spiritual coach to support and guide them on their path.

A spiritual coach does not coach as a profession or as a hobby.

A hobby meets one's emotional needs.

A profession meets one's material and monetary needs.

A 'calling' fulfils one's vision for one's life.

It is not my vision to be a coach.

Being a coach and coaching spiritual people allows me to fulfil my vision for my life. It is the means, the reason and the purpose.

Aligning others to their path in life, aligns my Self to my path.

Empowering others empowers my Self.

What I give to others, I allow my Self to receive more of.

I give to my clients my Time, my Space and my Reality.

These are the most essential elements of my abundant Life.

A Professional Coach

A Professional Coach coaches as a profession.

When Coaching is a profession, it is a business and it is commercial.

Commercial businesses and professions operate within a set of professional guidelines.

A professional service is required to give value for the fees charged for that commercial service.

A professional coach is required to coach professional people.

An aim and objective of professional people is to become more professional so that they can make more money.

The aim of business and commerce is to make money.

The aim of a professional coach is to make money.

A business that is not professional does not make money and will soon go out of business.

An activity that costs money is called a hobby.

Hobby coaches are not seen as professional people.

Spiritual Coaching is neither a profession nor a hobby.

It is a calling.

“Many are called, few are chosen”.

The Team Coach

The Team Coach neither leads the team nor manages the team.

The Team Manager manages the team's objectives by effectively using the team to effect those objectives.

The Team Leader leads the team to achieve the objectives that are agreed with the Team Manager.

The Team Coach guides and supports the individual team members to complete the tasks required to meet the team's objectives.

The Team Trainer trains the individual team members to achieve the level of skill required to complete the tasks of the team to the agreed standard that is required.

The Team Coach coaches the team to use their skills, qualities & experience in the most effective way and facilitates the changes required for the team to overcome all the resistance, obstacles & problems that is hindering their progress towards their intended goals.

Team Coaching is much more than assisting individual team members to overcome their problems.

The Team Coach is concerned with the individual personal development of each individual team member and their integration within the team, so that the output of the team becomes exponentially greater than the sum of the potential of each individual member of the team.

Being A Teacher

Being a Teacher is not teaching others.

Teaching others is what teachers purport to do.

Being a Teacher is a state of Being not an act of teaching.

The act of teaching is carried out by one who is acting as a teacher.

Being a Teacher is the 3rd Way between the duality of Master & Student.

Teaching people by giving them knowledge may overcome their ignorance but it will never connect them to their own True Path.

A tutor asks the questions that reconnect the student to their own answers.

A teacher answers questions whereas, a tutor asks the questions.

A pupil requires the answers from their teacher.

A student requires the questions from their tutor.

When the tutor asks the right question, the student already has the right answer.

A teacher works with rational knowledge.

A tutor works with intuitive knowing.

A tutor requires both rational & emotional intelligence.

It is my spiritual intelligence that connects me to my Inner Tutor.

It is spiritual intelligence that allows the tutor to connect their student to their own Inner Coach and intuitive guidance system.

A Therapist

A Therapist is a level two coach.

A therapist understands the challenges that a client faces.

Our challenges come from within, never without.

Other people do not challenge me.

A therapist never challenges the client but allows the client to see their own challenges clearly, which is the skill of being challenging.

We are all challenged by our fears, our limiting beliefs & our emotional needs.

The therapist enables the client by reconnecting them to their power & their authority.

I am only ever challenged by a lack of emotional power.

My emotional power is depleted by my lack of mental authority.

My lack of authority is my greatest challenge.

My fears & limiting beliefs disallow my authority and cause my emotional needs that manifest the dramas in my life that challenge me.

Meeting those challenges requires a therapist that applies a therapy that is a treat and a treat meant for me.

An Appraiser

An Appraiser appraises personal attributes, attainments & qualities. The quality of a personal attribute attained is appraised by an Appraiser.

Appraising is a coaching skill.

An appraisal identifies the quality of attributes attained relative to the quality of attributes aspired to.

- An Appraiser values property & belongings to assess their worth.
- An Appraiser assesses personal mental worth & personal emotional wealth.

A personal appraisal identifies emotional competence & mental capacity.

Self-confidence, self-worth & self-esteem are all subject to appraisal.

An appraisal evaluates what is good, what is better & what is best for each Individual.

It is a spiritual assessment of the authority of personal faith & the value of personal power.

A Mentor

A Mentor is a level one Coach.

A Mentor has previous experience of the path that the client is following.

They facilitate the path of the coachee.

The skill of the mentor is to allow the mentee to make their own choices.

It is not the role of the mentor to teach the right path to follow.

The right choice for the client is the path that they know and feel is right for them.

The role of a level one coach is to align the client with their effortless path.

Stage one on their path is to overcome problems.

It is not the mentors role to overcome or solve the problems that the client faces.

It is the coach's role to guide & support the client to become problem-free.

Once problem-free the coachee can clearly see their challenges.

The Mentors role is to hear and to clarify the client's challenges.

A Coach

A Coach is a person who guides and supports another on their path of personal or professional development.

A Personal Development Coach or Life Coach guides & supports someone on their path of development in life.

A Professional Development Coach, Corporate Coach or Business Coach guides & supports someone on their path to develop their business or their role in their business or chosen professional occupation.

What defines a Coach as distinct from a Teacher, Trainer, Consultant or Therapist is that the process is always client driven and not practitioner driven.

A Coach focuses on hearing and clarifying the development path of the client not the Coach.

The primary skills of a Coach are the ability to listen and to empower.

Listening facilitates the connection of the client to the direction of their development path.

Empowering supports the client to follow their direction with clarity.

A client's potential is realised through the awareness of the authority that they hear and the magnitude of the emotional power that they feel.

A Life Coach

The purpose of any journey is to get from one situation to another.

The purpose of a Coach is to facilitate that journey.

The most important journey in my life is the one that takes me along my own unique & individual life path towards my destiny. An exclusive path through life requires an exclusive means of transport to reach that destination.

The destination of my life path is called my destiny.

Whatever happens on my journey can be my unconscious fate or my conscious choice. Using a Coach is a choice.

The role of a Coach is to ensure that the journey is enjoyable & effortless, whilst holding the vision of the destination.

Life journeys are a mystery tour.

An effective Coach allows the mystery tour to unfold so that the miracle of the experience can be fully experienced and appreciated.

Few would attempt the journey without a competent Coach as their guide.

The Analyst

The Analyst highlights the obstacles that are causing resistance to the flow of Life. The Analyst identifies the causes of what we have mis-created in Life.

The Analyst sees Life from many different perspectives.

The Analyst knows that everyone creates their own version of reality.

The Analyst requires the skills of both consciousness and awareness.

Without awareness, the Analyst will seek perfect solutions and need to be right.

With the need to be right and perfect, the Analyst will become an anal-yst.

An Analyst cannot perform with their head stuck up their rectum.

The Analyst knows that what appears to be a problem in life, is in fact an opportunity for personal growth and development.

The Analyst gives direction to the lost, clarity to the confused and ability to the frustrated, on their unique, individual and exclusive journey through Life.

They awaken only to a new day, with a hang-over from the previous year without any elation or revelation.

To the awakened, aware & connected Reveller, every new year, new month or new day reveals an opportunity for the further expansive development & growth of their Soul.

Daily revelations allow a New Age Reveller to orient their life along an effortless path of valuable opportunity, on the personal journey of their own unique destiny in these new enlightened & revealing times.

The Nurturer

The Nurturer allows others to grow. The Nurturer is open and connected.

The Nurturer is sensitive to the needs of others and aware of their emotional state of Being.

The Nurturer empowers others on their personal path.

The Nurturer understands that without power, we cannot progress along our path.

The Nurturer knows that our personal path of development is to grow spiritually.

The Nurturer incubates the seeds that others have sown.

The gift of Nurture requires the attainment of detachment to allow sensitivity to be effective.

We all need a Nurturer to support us on our path when our growth hits resistance and our batteries are depleted.

When I facilitate the growth of others, others facilitate my growth.

When I nurture others, others nurture me.

I nurture others with my guidance & my support.

I guide others along their own path of development with insights and revelations.

I support others to get their emotional needs met and to empower their own actions.

Nurturing others allows their own inspiration to authorise their own aspirations.

The Nurturer allows development & growth to occur naturally.

It occurs with the effortless expansive flow that is the nature of the universe.

Nurture & nature are not a duality, they are not in opposition.

They work perfectly in balance & harmony and are never in conflict.

Being the Nurturer is the nature of a Coach.

A Sensitive

A Sensitive is playing the role of a person who is particularly sensitive to the emotional energy of other people.

As many people in our society today are insensitive and emotionally disconnected, a Sensitive can often be very helpful. Consulting a Sensitive person when having problems relating to being either too sensitive or being insensitive can be most beneficial.

A Sensitive is able to resolve issues and problems affecting people who have become either too sensitive or insensitive to life.

Being a Sensitive is often viewed by a disconnected, unemotional or insensitive person as being paranormal or occult.

A rational scientific view that only sees the physical aspects of life as normal, logical and relevant perceives the paranormal & occult with negativity & scepticism.

A spiritually religious view that only sees the dogma and doctrine of their own religious interpretation as true & good perceives the paranormal & occult as false & evil.

Being a Sensitive is neither scientific nor religious, but it is by its very nature Spiritual even though it is currently beyond the remit of both science or religion.

A Regulator

The purpose of a Regulator is to balance a system.

The purpose of a Coaching Regulator is to ensure that the consumer receives a balanced service.

A balanced service means that it is mutually beneficial to both the coach and the client.

Where a service is practitioner driven, it is necessary to ensure that the perspective of the practitioner is customer focused.

Regulations & rules are often deemed essential to ensure that the customer is protected from an unbalanced professional or an unprofessional perspective of the practitioner.

Coaching is always client driven.

The role of the Regulator is to ensure that Coaching is always client driven.

A consumer does not need rules & regulations imposed by an external source onto the provider.

The only rule that is required to be regulated is that coaching be client driven.

A Coach never seeks to be regulated and does not seek to regulate their clients.

The only rule that needs regulation is that there are no rules, only balance between the coach and their client.

Master & Slave

Master & Slave is a role duality that expresses the same energy from opposing perspectives. It is a drama created from our emotional need to be better than others and our limiting belief that we are not all equal. It is an expression in relative dual reality of our sins of greed & pleasing, arrogance & humbleness and pride & humility.

A master of slaves will never master their own destiny. It is not our destiny to be a master of anyone or a slave of anyone, but it may become our fate. It is not our destiny to become the slave of our Soul, as our Soul has granted our Self free will.

It is our destiny to become the attributes of our Soul and attain the choice of our Soul, whilst in relative physical reality.

Expert & Master

The role of the Soul is to be the Master of the Self.

The Ego Self acts on behalf of the Soul, once it has awakened to its true destiny - the Path of its Soul.

Paul became a saint and an evangelist.

Jesus was a Messiah not an evangelist.

A Messiah has a Divine Message for Mankind.

A divine message is always good news.

Preaching someone else's gospel is not always good news.

An Angel is a spiritual guardian or guide.

Angels act on a personal & individual level.

A Messiah works with a race or a nation on a global level.

Both a Messiah & an Angel are divinely guided.

An evangelical evangelist follows their own calling or creed.

Saint Or Mother

A Saint is the opposing role to a Sinner.

In the eyes of the church, a Sinner is someone adjudged to do wrong.

A Saint is someone who does good deeds for others.

The Christian religion defines good deeds as virtues & bad deeds as sins.

Saints are virtuous & good, Sinners are sinful & bad.

Spirituality sees sins as male energy & virtues as female energy.

There is no judgment in spiritual reality only in religiosity.

The female virtues of humbleness, humility, kindness, caring, pleasing, poverty & duty are all the virtues of a True Mother.

Sins are the male energy of an assertive leader or Father.

Virtues are the female energy of a nurturing Mother or follower.

As female virtues are seen to be good, they are also the qualities attributed to a Saint.

The Overcomer is: Sensitively-Rational

Sensitive to the opposing dualities of life and able to rationally discover a third way of being, in order to overcome the dual realities.

The Comforter is: Emotionally-Detached

To comfort others, I am required to be detached and stand in my own power whilst sharing my emotional power in a positive and expansive way.

The Healer is: Sensitively-Detached

Sensitively aware of the energetic emotional disposition of others, yet able to be transparent to and detached from their problems and mis-alignment.

The Messiah is: Exclusively Connected

Connected to and hearing my own exclusive messages that inspire, empower, enlighten and reveal my own personal path of expansive growth.

The Saviour is: Exclusively, Rationally and Detachedly-Connected

Exclusively connected to my Soul, whilst being rationally conscious of my Self, yet detached from all other people energetically.

The Observer

The Observer is the one who sees all.

The Observer is neither in judgment nor non-judgment.

The Observer sees the Big Picture.

The Observer is my Soul & Inner Coach.

My Soul sees everything and says nothing, unless first asked.

My Observer sees my Life Path and the direction that it takes.

My Observer sees everything that occurs in my life as an opportunity.

Observing is a state of being, not a state of doing.

My Observer sees all with my intuitive sense of feeling and knowing.

My Observer feels the presence, feels the gap, and feels the flow that allow my expansive growth to occur.

My Observer knows my path, knows my destiny, and knows my vision for this life-time.

As the Observer, I am all Seeing, all Knowing, and all Feeling.

The Redeemer

The Redeemer is the one who reclaims their own power, authority and ability. We redeem our power when we become who we really are.

We redeem our authority when we make the choices of our Soul.

We redeem our ability when we reclaim our power and authority.

We all have choice and the Redeemer is always at Choice.

The Redeemer remembers their Vision, Mission and Purpose for this life-time.

The Redeemer has the authority and knows the choices that are required to follow their Life Path.

The Redeemer has the power to be their authentic Self.

The Redeemer is fulfilled with wisdom, is healthy with contentment and has a wealth of joy in their life.

The Redeemer redeems their True Self in the image of their Soul, from whence they were created.

The Overcomer

The Overcomer is the one who overcomes the paradox of dual reality existence.

We live in a world of opposing opposites.

A Pilgrimage is a journey of the Soul.

It is a journey of Faith.

It is inspired by a Vision.

It is the fulfilment of a Purpose.

It is a unique Mission.

Every Pilgrimage is personal to each Individual Pilgrim.

It is all about the Journey.

It is the fate of a Pilgrim to reach a destination.

It is the destiny of a Pilgrim to undertake the journey.

When a pilgrimage is a physical journey, it will not have a spiritual outcome.

A journey to the birth-place of a religious leader may or may not be a part of my journey.

A Dutiful Son

A Dutiful Son:

Believes that it is his duty to follow the authority and the example of his parents.

Follows the beliefs that he has inherited from his parents. Respects the boundaries laid down by his parents. Pleases the greed of his parents power.

Is humble to the arrogance of his parents authority.

Is proud to be related to such upstanding and righteous parents.

Believes that it is his duty to be a good son.

Is the good son that his parents want.

Believes that a good son always does what his parents want.

The 'Son of Man' has no duty to pay to his parents. His True Mother & Father are the Love & Light of his own Power & Authority.

The Alpha Male

The Alpha Male has the belief that being, superior, arrogant & assertive is a characteristic of the dominant males of a species. It is actually a characteristic of male energy.

The male & female gender of emotional energy has become confused with masculine & feminine physical characteristics.

Just because a Man has a big ego doesn't mean that he has to assert his arrogant superiority.

Women are just as capable of asserting their arrogant superiority, which they invariably do when raising & protecting their young.

Assertive, superior arrogance is seen as a positive trait of any person, male or female, playing the role of Provider or Protector.

Inferior, meek & humble individuals fail miserably to provide for or protect either themselves or their families.

Alpha male energy is particularly pertinent in a society that believes that only the fittest survive and only the best evolve in a process of natural selection.

Alpha male leaders are dependent on their followers and their ability to assert their arrogant superior authority over their followers.

The Alpha Female

The Alpha Female is an oxymoron.

Alpha Male energy is superior, arrogant & assertive.

When a female is asserting her superiority, arrogance & assertiveness, she is expressing the characteristics of her male energy. She is acting the role of an alpha male.

Displaying the characteristics of an alpha male makes you an alpha male, irrespective of your masculine or feminine sex.

Male or female gender of energy is not masculine or feminine sex specific.

Alpha female describes the gender of the energy not the sex of the person. Physical human beings have a masculine or feminine sex determined at their birth.

Emotional Energy has a male or female gender determined by its physical expression.

Female human beings are as able to express male emotional energy characteristics as well as male human beings can.

Alpha Male is a description of one's character based on one's beliefs and one's personality based on one's emotional needs.

Personal beliefs and emotional needs are not gender specific.

The only belief that is sex specific is whether I believe that I am a girl or a boy.

Leaders & Followers

Leaders are by nature selfish and are motivated to do what is best for them self.

Followers are by nature unselfish and are motivated to do what is best for others.

What determine whether I am a leader or a follower are my emotional needs.

Leaders need to lead because leading meets their emotional needs.

Followers need to follow because following meets their emotional needs.

When a leader understands and meets the needs of their followers, their followers are truly motivated to follow them.

When a follower meets the needs of their leader, their leader is truly motivated to lead.

However, neither leaders nor followers are empowered.

My empowerment comes from following my own path and it is not my path to either lead or follow anyone.

Empowered people lead their own lives and follow their own path.

They are Truly Selfish in that they follow the lead given by their True Self and they know that what is best for themselves is also what is best for all others.

Followers

Natural followers need leaders to follow.

Natural leaders need followers to follow them.

True Followers lead their own Life and True Leaders follow their own Life Path.

True Followers are Disciples of the Truth.

Disciples of the Truth follow their own path and their own truth, and lead by example of their own truth.

Natural followers have humility and renounce their own authority in favour of the authority of another.

Natural followers are humble and adopt a lower stance than their leader, believing that they have less ability.

Natural followers please their leader, in order to share the power that they believe that their leader possesses.

Natural followers need to be liked, need to be included, and need approval.

True Followers follow the Authority of their Inner Guidance or Inner Coach, that allows their Power to flow from Source, and enables authentic purpose.

A True Follower is a Disciple of their Soul.

Leaders

Natural Leadership qualities are the product of the nature of the leader. A natural follower has the qualities and the nature of a follower.

What decides our nature and our qualities to either lead or follow, are our emotional needs.

Leaders need to be right, need to be better than others, need to be recognised and need to be acknowledged.

Leaders by nature are proud, greedy and arrogant.

Leaders appear to have power, authority and ability.

True Leaders are connected to their own source of power, authority and ability.

Natural leaders seek power, authority and ability over other people, because they need to achieve, they need to win, and they need to

be appreciated,
accepted and revered by others.

These are just some of the emotional needs that determine the nature of natural leaders, and the nature of their determination.

True Leaders are neither driven by their emotional need for power, nor their fears and false beliefs regarding authority and responsibility.

True Leaders have the 'ability to respond'. They do not react and conflict with the dramas of Life that confront them.

True Leaders feel their true power, know their true authority and see the bigger picture of their Life and the ability that they have to 'lead' their own Life.

The Participator, The Spectator, & The Observer

The Spectator is one who watches the participator.

The spectator and the participator are a duality and a human drama. We have a choice as to whether we participate in life or whether we become a spectator and watch others participate in life.

The Participator takes part in the action, whereas spectators only watch. Participating or spectating is the choice of the ego self and is dependent on the emotional needs and limiting beliefs of the individual. It is only our fears and limiting beliefs that stop us participating in life and become a spectator. Whether we participate or just watch, we are following our fate.

The Observer is the Divine Choice of our Soul and Inner coach. To Observe is to objectively serve.

The role of the ego self is to subjectively serve (sub-serve).

The Soul is the Observer of the Self, whether the Self chooses to spectate or participate. The Soul is always there to Observe the Self and to Objectively serve the Self in all moments of Time.

An Opportunist

An Opportunist sees each day as an opportunity for Personal Spiritual Development and Growth.

An opportunity for Personal development arises as:

A limiting belief to be challenged and cleared.

An emotional need to be met.

A life drama to be overcome.

An opportunity for Spiritual growth is the opportunity to become an aspect of our True Identity. As we become who we really are, we connect to our true Authority and are able to hold more of our Spiritual Power as our energy vibration increases. We become more like our true Self as we make choices about who we no longer choose to be.

An Opportunist takes every opportunity to discover, explore and experience Life. We redeem our True Identity by challenging the limiting beliefs that our old character was convicted by, and meeting the emotional needs that determined our previous personality.

An Opportunist no longer acts out their role in the continuing dramas of Life.

An Opportunist takes every opportunity to create their own Life as the Reality of their own Choice.

A Realist

A Realist believes that their Reality is REAL.

The reality of a Realist is what appears to be literally true. What is literally true is what can be verified by our 5 physical senses as literally physically true. The truth of a Realist is based on their beliefs.

A Realist:

Believes that their truth is real and they believe it to be the true reality.

Believes that there is only one reality and what is real for them is real for everyone who is sane.

Has no comprehension of the possible existence of multiple realities.

Believes that Reality was either created by "God" or is an accident of "Science".

The Law of Attraction implies that the focus of our thoughts creates our Reality. It follows that as we all have different thoughts and emotions, with different perspectives and perceptions of life, that we all experience different Realities.

The Law of Attraction is a Reality for anyone who wishes to create their own Reality.

Unfortunately this is not the Reality for Realists because when we believe that there is only one reality, that becomes our experience.

A Trialist

A Trialist is an adherent to the trialities of life.

A Trialist always chooses the third way.

A Trialist believes that the 3rd Way is divine.

A Trialist has overcome the relative choices of a dual reality world.

A Trialist is aware that there are always three choices.

A Trialist knows that the 3rd choice is always at the fulcrum of the other two.

A Trialist is aware that the third choice always brings the other two choices into balance.

A Trialist seeks a life of balance & harmony, with inner peace.

A Trialist knows that life is not a trial, there is no judgment, no blame, no conviction and no punishment.

A Trialist only sees life as a trial or a lesson when an opportunity has been missed.

A Trialist knows that Oneness is not a singularity but a triality of relative experiences in a dual reality world.

Optimist & Pessimist

An Optimist looks at Life from a positive perspective. An Optimist is optimistic about positive events occurring and pessimistic about negative things occurring.

A Pessimist looks at Life from a negative perspective. A Pessimist is pessimistic about positive events occurring and optimistic about negative things occurring.

What determines our positive or negative outlook is our pessimistic or optimistic perspective. By the Law of Attraction, we attract and experience what we focus our attention on.

An Optimist will attract a positive outcome and a Pessimist will attract a negative outcome, even though the actual outcome may be the same. Both Optimists and Pessimists believe that we make our own luck. The question is "Whether we make good luck or bad luck"?

The Opportunist does not believe in Luck and knows that we all create our own Reality.

Saints & Sinners

Saints & Sinners are a duality of religious morality.

What the church judges to be immoral and bad is called a sin.

What the church judges to be moral and good is called a virtue.

Saints are judged to be virtuous, sinners are judged to be immoral.

A sinner is guilty of expressing the male aspects of their emotional energy, which are:

- Pride
- Envy
- Gluttony
- Lust
- Greed
- Wrath
- Sloth

These are called the 7 mortal sins that are judged by the church to be deadly.

A saint has innocence by virtue of expressing the female aspects of their emotional energy, which are:

- Humility
- Kindness (generosity)
- Scarcity (poverty)
- Human love (caring)
- Humbleness (pleasing)
- Meekness (patience)
- Hard work (due diligence)

These are called the 7 heavenly virtues and judged by the church to be saintly.

I believe Mother Theresa to be a shining example and the embodiment of Divine Love, not a candidate for sainthood, which requires the attainment of the above spiritual sins called virtues.

Being virtuous is expressing the sensitive, emotional and connected aspects of our personality but it is not Divine because it is not holy because it is not whole. Being Virtuous is being without the rational, exclusive and detached male aspects of our personality and therefore is not a Divine State of Being. Divinity requires balance. Yin without yang is never Divine.

The Guide

The Role of the Guide is neither:

- A master nor a slave
- A teacher nor a pupil
- A parent nor a child
- A leader nor a follower
- An employer nor an employee

A Guide does not teach, train, instruct, direct, lead, protect, consult, mentor or advise.

A Guide:

- Supports others on their own path
- Hears the messages that are directions on that path
- Explains the lessons that are required to be learned
- Outlines the shifts in perspective that are necessary to make
- Reveals the resolutions to the problems that are appearing
- Clarifies the challenges that are presenting
- Highlights the opportunities that are opening up
- Connects others to the power of their own inspiration
- Keeps the client 'present'
- Reveals the clients gifts (presents)
- Facilitates the clients presence
- A Guide is the modern day Messiah that accesses wisdom.

The Victim

Victimhood is a drama created by the belief that what is occurring is being created by something or someone other than one's Self. I become the victim of someone else's actions when I believe that I am.

I am only ever the victim of my own thoughts.

I am only ever the victim of my own reality that I have created with my own thoughts.

Fear is a false belief that I am attracting into my reality because of my belief in its existence.

I will become a victim of whatever I fear simply because I am focusing my thought upon that fear.

I am only ever the victim of a reality that I do not want.

I do not see myself as a victim of the reality that I consciously choose.

I am therefore only ever a victim of the reality that I sub-consciously choose.

When I do not want the reality that I have chosen, whether at a conscious or a sub-conscious level, I am free to make a new choice.

Victimhood ceases to be when I realise that I have always been the victim of my own choice, which is the focus of my own thoughts.

I overcome victimhood when I take responsibility for my thoughts and actions, and I no longer give my fears another thought.

I can only ever be a victim of my Self and the creator of my own victimhood.

When I can see the victimhood of another person, I can no longer become their victim.

When I can see another in the role of the victim they cannot be the villain and therefore I cannot be their victim.

When I have no distinction between the victim and the villain, there is no duality, and no drama exists. Equality is achieved and victimhood is overcome.

When I am no longer a victim of life, I am no longer a victim in my life.

When I know that I am the creator of my own life, I am no longer the victim of my life.

I cannot be the victim of my life and the villain that created it.

When I am both the victim and the villain in my life, I have overcome the duality and I have achieved a state of being in equanimity with myself. My Soul shares equanimity with my Self.

I can only ever be a victim of my own choices or my choice not to choose.

Once I know that I have choice, I know that I create my reality with my choices and I am a creator by choice.

I am a creator whether I choose to be or not.

When I know that I created my own victimhood, then I know that I can uncreate it and I never need to play that role again in my life.

The Saboteur

The Saboteur:

- Is the aggressive victim.
- Will sabotage all attempts to form meaningful relationships.
- Is a victim of a relationship because they sabotage any relationship that is constructive.
- Is the villain of their own victimhood.
- Is the creator of their own victimhood.
- Believes that a pre-emptive strike is the only defense against attack.
- Is unable to form a constructive relationship because they are unaware of the purpose of relationships.
- Cannot see who they are being.
- Sees them self as the victim of who someone else is being.
- Believes that the only way to stop being a victim of a relationship is to sabotage or destroy the relationship.

The purpose of a relationship is to see and experience who we are being in relationship to another person.

How we relate to others is a reflection of how they relate to us.

The Hero

The Hero is the brave rescuer.

The Hero rescues victims in times of disaster.

Disasters occur when we have created chaos by being the victim of too many problems.

We believe that we need a Hero to rescue us from our fate, our doom and our misfortune.

Every Hero makes a victim out of a villain.

We cannot be a Hero without competing in the drama of the victim & the villain.

All heroes will eventually become victims of their own heroism.

Bravery & courage are the strength of will power needed to be a hero.

Our Inner Coach is our Saviour, not our rescuer.

Our Saviour requires no bravery or courage, just the purest Power of Love & Authority of Light.

The Peaceful Warrior

There is the 'Way of the Warrior', there is the 'Way of the Pacifist', and there is a 3rd Way – the way of the "Peaceful Warrior".

The Peaceful Warrior is seen as an oxymoron because war and peace are a duality.

An oxymoron is believed not to exist because it is combining two opposing perspectives of reality.

In a dualistic world, I can be either a pacifist or a warrior, but not both.

In a triune reality world, I have three choices and may therefore choose to be a Peaceful Warrior.

In a Trialistic World, paradox not only exists but is the norm.

Paradoxes are my 'Trials'.

I move into a World of Triality when I see the paradox and discover the 3rd Way.

A Peaceful Warrior neither fights for peace nor fights for war.

As a Peaceful Warrior I confront my own Life without conflict or appeasement.

A Peaceful Warrior has overcome the drama of 'the Victim & the Villain', has no arrogance or humbleness and pleases the greed of no-one.

A Light Worker

A Light Worker works with the Universal Energy of Light.

A Light Worker understands the Energy of Light.

The Energy of Light carries the Authority of our Soul.

The Authority of our Soul connects us to the Power of Love.

A Light Worker works with the Power of Love whilst connected to the Authority of its Soul.

The Mission of a Light Worker is to 'save' its Self.

When a Light Worker has saved its Self from the relative dual reality world of physical existence, it becomes the Saviour of its Self.

The process of becoming a Saviour is the ability to increase the amount of Light that we can access.

Light is information that is received from the Universal Consciousness of All that Is.

A Light Worker does not seek the Truth but seeks to connect to the Truth by raising their vibration sufficiently to access their power and ability to connect to their Truth.

A Visionary

A Visionary:

- Knows their purpose for this life-time.
- Can see and understand what they have come here to do.
- Knows who they are and why they are here.
- Has a direction in which to lead their Life.

When we have no direction for our life, we get lost very easily.

Our Vision for this life is how we have decided to make a difference in this world.

How we make a difference in this world is how we will be remembered.

To be remembered in this life, we are required to remember our Vision.

A Seer has the intuitive gift of insight for seeing another person's path.

A Visionary knows only their own path in Life.

An Avatar

An Avatar is a physical embodiment of a spiritually divine state of Being,

Being an Avatar is an ideal and absolutely beneficial way to experience physical reality. It is a state of 5 dimensional mental awareness, which embodies the oneness or unity of Sovereign Christ Consciousness.

Krishna, Christ & Buddha are three historical examples of Avatars who, having attained 5th Dimensional Spiritual Conscious-Awareness, were able to ground it in a 3 dimension physical reality. Avatars know from their own experience that they are the Creator of their own ideal reality, whilst in physical form. They have overcome the two dimensional reality of the mental sickness of the Zombie and the 3 dimensional emotional disconnection of the Automaton. They have journeyed through their 4th dimensional awareness, as an Initiate of their own intuitive emotions to become a 5th dimensional, Sovereign Entity; who has mastered the Astral, Corporeal & Etheric Realms to become a unique Spiritual Individual, with an exclusive Identity.

Automatons & Zombies

An Automaton is a person who acts mechanically or leads a routine, monotonous life. An Automaton believes that their body is an organic machine, which runs automatically until it becomes sick, ill, diseased, damaged or broken. When not able to operate at full capacity, the Automaton checks in with a doctor or physician for a regular service and diagnosis of faults. An Automaton expects its physician to keep its physical body running efficiently, in the same way that it expects a garage mechanic to service their car. The philosophy of an Automaton explains their reality by referring to causally determined external forces of a material nature, which are seen as their problem requiring someone else's solution. An Automaton is programmed to work at full capacity to alleviate the monotony of a boring life.

A Zombie, like an Automaton, is an apathetic person who appears to be lifeless and lacking in independent judgment, to the degree that they are on a fatal path of morbid mortality towards an inevitable demise. A Zombie is an Automaton with a contagious disease that can affect other Automatons. Automatons are therefore programmed to fear Zombies and avoid their prognosis of a slow & painful death. A Zombie is programmed to suffer the pain of an incurable disease under the conditions of social exclusion, emotional trauma and mental drama; whereas an Automaton is either programmed to suffer the pain of insufficient pleasure or is driven to meet their continuous need for their own personal addictive desires.

The antidote for both the Automaton & the Zombie is a healthy dose of an emotionally intelligent, exclusive connection to their own source of spiritual guidance & support.

A Sorcerer

A Sorcerer is one who sees the essence of things.

The essence of everything is energy.

A Sorcerer is one who perceives the energetic essence of life.

The capacity to perceive the energetic essence of life is called seeing. The energetic essence of life is its Source.

A Sorcerer is one who sees the energetic source of life.

The Source of Life is Consciousness.

A Sorcerer is one who has an awareness of the levels of consciousness of the mind that are realised through thought.

A Sorcerer is one who has an awareness of the wavelengths of emotion on which all thoughts are experienced.

Sorcery is the awareness of the frequency of thoughts that one's mind is transmitting & receiving.

The essence of everything is its energy vibration.

A sorcerer is one who sees the filaments of universal light energy that a person is assembling as their conscious or sub-conscious reality.

The role of the Sorcerer in today's world is to guide & support others to see the essence of who they really are.

A modern Sorcerer has a deep understanding of the authority of personal thought and the power of personal emotion.

This emotional power & mental authority of the inner Self is the creative energy that allows personal reality to be beneficially experienced.

A Sorcerer is one who intuitively sees the energetic reality that is creating a person's experience and intuitively sees the shifts that are essential for a person to connect to the essence of who they really are.

A Sorcerer is a Source Seer who sees the source of individual creativity & personal reality.

Our True Identity

Our True Identity is who we really are. Our True Identity is our Soul. In the absence of, or disconnection from, our True Identity, we create an alter ego called our Self.

Our Self has two dimensions called our Character and our Personality. The character of our Self is determined by our mental programmes and limiting beliefs that are contained in our sub-conscious Id.

The personality of our Self is determined by our emotional needs. The character and personality that we adopt determine our Role in the Drama called Life.

Our Soul is a three dimensional Entity when viewed from the perspective of the Self:

- The Attributes of our Soul are the emotional states of Being that our Soul has chosen to experience in this life-time.

They are my states of being; the vibrations of emotion with which I resonate; the gifts that I am born with.

I have attained emotional attributes with which I can resonate as my natural state of being.

Children of the same family will have different personalities & characters because, even though they may share the same beliefs and similar emotional needs, they all have different attributes that are their unique gift that they have attained and present in this life-time as an expression of their true identity.

It is the true identity of my personal attributes & attainments that is attractive to other people, not my personality & character.

It is my true identity that attracts people with a similar true identity, so that we may share our attributes in the attainment of our mutual personal spiritual development & growth.
